Tom DeWeese is one of the nation's leading advocates of individual liberty, free enterprise, private property rights, personal privacy, back-to-basics education and American sovereignty and independence.

A native of Ohio, he's been a candidate for the Ohio Legislature, served as editor of two newspapers, and has owned several businesses since the age of 23. In 1989 Tom led the only privately-funded election-observation team to the Panamanian elections. In 2006 Tom was invited to Cambridge University to debate the issue of the United Nations before the Cambridge Union, a 200 year old debating society. Today he serves as Founder and President of the American Policy Center and editor of The DeWeese Report. Tom also heads up an Internet news site called Freedom21.com.

Michael J. Chapman, founder of American Heritage Research, is an author, speaker, and education researcher. He owns an extensive collection of rare books, which he uses to expose extensive worldview bias and censorship within mainstream public school curriculum. He has conducted in-service training for teachers in several states. Michael has appeared locally and nationally on such shows as "Point of View" with Marlin Maddoux, Phyllis Schlafly "Live," and John Loeffler's "Steel on Steel."

Mr. Chapman has spoken at national conferences including the Education Policy Conference in St. Louis, Eagle Forum, and the Council on National Policy in Washington, D.C. He has presented to staff at Focus on the Family and the ACSI and has conducted extensive research for local and nationally elected representatives. Michael, and his wife of 34 years, recently moved to Carrollton, Texas.
